Dear FUPC Family and Friends,

As you may remember, we will celebrate the Lord's Supper the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month through Pentecost (May 23). Please have communion elements with you when you Zoom in for worship this Sunday, March 7.

As the old broadcasting saying goes, "We interrupt your normally scheduled program for this broadcast event." On Sunday we will be interrupting our look at Scriptural texts from Luke's gospel to focus on an opportunity that your Session and I are very excited about. I'd like to give you a little bit of background.

A few weeks ago, I realized that I will be eligible to take a Sabbatical in 2022. Just as God's people are told in Exodus 23 to work for six days and take a Sabbath on the seventh, and to sow and reap the land for six years and then let it lie fallow for a year, the PC(USA) provides for a time of sabbatical for its Ministers of Word and Sacrament each seventh year. (Seven is a number of completeness, and so this time of rest and renewal is a way of completing a cycle.) And yes, believe it or not, I will complete my 6th year with you in the spring of 2022, and enter into my seventh.

I believe that it's important to see this sabbatical time not only as a time for the pastor's renewal, but for the congregation's as well. It offers time while the pastor is away for the congregation to explore and see things in new ways by interacting with new ideas and new voices. In fact, when I checked in with the presbytery office to get information about preparing for a sabbatical, I learned that the Lilly Foundation offers a Clergy Renewal Grant Program to fund both pastor and congregation to engage in renewal. The Session has embraced this opportunity, and we hope you, the congregation, will as well. On Sunday, I will be sharing with you my plans for renewal, and exploring with you ideas for FUPC's renewal during this time. I am thinking of our renewal time with the theme "Exploring the W(w)ord." We all want to be continually renewed by The Word—the capital "w" Word, God's word for us in Scripture and in Christ. But we have our own words to explore as well—who each of us is as a unique and beloved child of God, what gifts each of us has been given, and in what ways we each live God's words in our lives. What do we love to do? How do we recharge? How do we engage others? How does each of us "speak ourselves" in the world?

I hope worship this week will allow you to "catch the Spirit" of this renewal opportunity. We have much work to do to prepare our proposal, which is due on April 21st. But how wonderful to think ahead to a time of engaging with God's Word and with each other's "words"—however they're expressed—during this special season in our church community.
