Stephen is a ruling elder – a sixth generation Presbyterian from the northern branch of the PC(USA). He is currently a member at Albuquerque, First PC and serves in leadership roles within the church. Stephen also serves as a volunteer board member for the Presbyterian Church (USA) Investment and Loan Program and the Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Austin, Texas. He has been Stated Clerk for the Presbytery of Santa Fe for the past 8 years and is now also serving as Commission on Ministry Associate supporting COM. Stephen and Kathy are the parents of two adult sons and have five grandchildren – 6 years of age and younger living in San Francisco and Denver.
