

MUSTARD SEED PROPOSALS Due March 28th, 2025

Since 1999, First United Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas has been inspired by the story of the mustard seed, providing more than \$170,000 to over 180 individuals and organizations for community outreach projects:

The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which someone took and sowed in his field; and this is smaller than all other seeds: but when it is full-grown it is larger than the garden plants and becomes a tree so that the birds of the air come and nest in its branches.

What We Fund

We provide "seed" money for special, new and innovative projects and one-time expenses. Requests to cover ongoing organizational expenses will not be funded. We fund projects in the following focus areas:

- Youth participation/benefit
- Mission within or beyond the community
- Community/church-related projects

We typically fund about ten projects a year. Proposals are evaluated on need, outreach potential, likelihood of success, alignment with our focus areas, and our church's mission statement:

How To Apply

Prepare a brief proposal that –

- Outlines your idea, details how the money will be spent, and who it will help (see focus areas above);
- Is signed by the leader of the group and a First United Presbyterian Church member (contact us if you need help finding a sponsor);
- Includes the name, address, phone number, and email address of the person who is submitting the request. Complete contact info must be included for funding consideration.

Submit proposals on or before Friday, March 28th, by noon by mail, e-mail, or dropping off at First United Presbyterian Church, Attention: Mustard Seed Committee
