Dear FUPC Family and Friends,

On Sunday we introduce our hybrid worship format, with some of us gathering in the sanctuary and others zooming in as we have been doing for more than a year now. It is a new venture for us. Everyone connected with the service has worked hard to make the transition go smoothly, but it's possible we'll have a glitch or two. Bear with us!

If you have reserved space in the sanctuary, we'll see you there! We understand that asking folks to reserve space for worship is antithetical to our "Everyone Welcome" philosophy, but distancing guidelines require us to know how many folks will be in attendance so we can maximize our space.

We will ask those who attend in person to enter via the main, double doors into the sanctuary (unless you need the ramp for access) and to also leave through those doors at the end of worship, maintaining distance between you and others. We will not hold fellowship time in Perea Hall following the service.

If you are planning to Zoom in for worship, what can you expect? An experience very similar to what you've been experiencing on Zoom. Our sanctuary camera will focus on the pulpit or the lectern so that you will have a closeup view of the speaker; likewise, it will focus on the communion table when we have communion.

Music will continue to be recorded and both those who use Zoom and who are in the sanctuary will hear the music and see the accompanying videos on their computer screens or on the sanctuary monitors.

Someone asked me how I feel about our move to hybrid worship. My reply was that I'm a bit nervous about it—have I thought through all the details so that things will go smoothly? But I have been working with a phenomenal tech crew and worship committee to plan for the change and I'm also very excited about its possibilities to bring us together in a new way. Imagine the possibilities when folks can zoom into our sanctuary from anywhere, when we can ask people to participate in worship in a variety of ways from wherever they are, when we can have guest preachers and speakers without worrying about whether they live close enough to make the drive! Our worship experience holds the promise of being richer and more inclusive than ever.

Whether you worship from the sanctuary or from home this Sunday, remember that we are "The Church at Work" during this season of Pentecost. Many thanks to Charlotte Wootton and Susan Apodaca who designed a sanctuary environment that reminds us that the Spirit is always with us!
