Dear FUPC Family and Friends,

I'm writing to you this evening from a hotel room in Liberal, Kansas. D.R. and I are on our way home after my nephew's memorial service over the weekend. As is usually true of those occasions, it was a difficult time, but there was the upside of seeing family I'd not seen for a long time. In addition to the family members we saw at the memorial service, D.R. and I made it a point to go through Wichita today (we usually don't take that route) so we could have lunch with a childhood friend of mine. She and I met through our older sisters, who were friends, when we were four years old. We hadn't seen her in 14 years! As I get older and as I experience the grief of unexpected loss—like my nephew, who died suddenly at 48 from a massive heart attack—it becomes more important to me to take every opportunity I can to stay connected to people who are important to me. After all, God made us for relationship!

This Sunday, we have an opportunity to learn about some ancient relationships among a group of Persians who brought some teachings of Jesus to China. We'll welcome John Arnold to the pulpit to preach about the "Lost Sutras of Jesus." John will be leading the Sunday morning class beginning July 10 on a book about these Sutras, so if what you hear on Sunday intrigues you, plan to attend the class!
